Contest Information

Day of contest: 09/11/21

- 11:00am - Contestant meeting to review the day's activities and scoring parameters.
- 1:00pm - Bling My Ride event
- 2:00pm - Erect It event
- 2:30pm - Light My Fire event
- 6:30pm - Arrive at final event - prepare judge's shot
- 7:00pm - Remainder of contest events with judges

Event 1 - Bling my Ride. 1:00pm. Grass area adjacent to Lanai.

Contestants will decorate a golf cart for an announced theme using all provided dollar store items provided to them. Carts must be decorated without any prior decorating or preparation at all. If contestants don't have a golf cart, there will be golf carts available for them to decorate. Points will be awarded in accordance with the scoring system used throughout the contest. The contestant to complete the decorating first in an adequate and creative manner will receive the highest number of points. All judges will be present.

Event 2 - Erect It. 2:00pm. Grass area adjacent to Lanai.

Contestants must erect a small tent provided as quickly as possible. Points awarded for completion and success of tent erection in accordance with the point system used throughout the contest. All judges will be present.

Event 3 - Light my Fire. 2:30pm. Bonfire area.

Contestants must build a campfire as quickly as possible and keep it lit for a minimum of 5 minutes. Materials will be provided. You will be judged on completion time to light fire lit as well as how robust the fire is. Points awarded in accordance with the scoring system used throughout the contest. All judges will be present.

Evening of contest: 09/11/21

Pre-show. 6:30pm. Lanai.

Contestants must be backstage and ready for the contest no later than 6:30pm. Judges will be in place at 6:45pm.

Category 4 - Imbibe and Bribe. 6:30pm. Lanai.

Prior to the start of the contest, contestants will prepare and present a 1oz. shot for each judge. Shots must be on the judges table with a contestant number attached to the shot glasses. The number of judges will be disclosed at the 11:00am meeting. Judging will be blind. Failure to have your shot placed on the table prior to the start of the contest (7pm) will result in a zero score. Points will be awarded in accordance with the standard point system used throughout the contest.

Category 5 - Camp Wear or Wear Not. 7:00pm. Lanai.

Contestants should wear their most functional and fabulous camp attire. Points awarded for creativity and aspects of utilitarianism. You will be asked to describe your attire regarding its function and fashion! Points will be awarded in accordance with the standard point system used throughout the contest.

Category 6 - How Campy are You? 7:00pm. Lanai.

Randomly picked questions about the campground and its history asked to each contestant. Points awarded by number of creative and correct answers and in accordance with the standard point system used throughout the contest.
