Contest Information

Day before the contest (9/9/22):

A mandatory contestant meeting will be at 7pm Friday, the day before the contest. This will provide contestants the opportunity to meet judges, get 50/50 materials and necessary information.

Day of the contest (9/10/22):

Category 1 – 50/50 Challenge

Contestants will be issued raffle tickets and a collection bucket at the contestant meeting Friday evening, the day before the contest. Contestants will have until 7pm Saturday, the evening of the contest to sell as many tickets as possible using the pricing guide as discussed at the meeting on Friday. Points will be awarded in accordance with the scoring system used throughout the contest based on total tickets sold and funds raised. Location: Entire Campground. All judges will be monitoring contestant progress from Friday through Saturday, the evening of the contest (7pm-7pm).

Category 2 - Erect It.

Contestants must erect a small pole tent provided as quickly as possible. Points awarded for completion and success of tent erection in accordance with the point system used throughout the contest.

Category will be at 2:00pm the day of contest. Location TBD.

All judges will be present.

Category 3 - Light my Fire.

Contestants must build a campfire as quickly as possible and keep it lit for a minimum of 5 minutes. The first campfire to burn the rope above the pit is the winner. Points earned based on completion time to and success of fire lit in accordance with the scoring system used throughout the contest.

Category will be completed at 3:00pm the day of the contest. Location: Bonfire pit. All judges must be present.

Evening of the contest:

Contestants must be backstage and ready for the contest no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the contest at 7:00pm. During that time, they should have their shot placed on the judges table with their contestant number attached to the shot glasses. Judges will be in place 15 minutes prior to the contest at 7:00pm.

Category 4 - Imbibe and Bribe.

Prepare and present a shot for the judges. Prior to the start of contest, contestants will have their prepared shot on the judges table. Failure to have your shot placed on the table prior to the contest (7pm) will result in a zero score. Points will be awarded accordance with the standard point system used throughout the contest

Category 5 - Camp Wear or Wear Not.

Contestants must wear their most functional and fabulous camp attire - function and fashion! Points awarded for creativity and aspects of utilitarianism.

Category will be completed on stage the evening of contest and points will be awarded in accordance with the standard point system used throughout the contest.

Category 6 - How Campy are You?

Random questions about the campground and its history asked to each contestant. Points awarded by number of creative and correct answers and in accordance with the standard point system used throughout the contest. Category will be completed in the evening of the contest.
