FRIDAY - 09/08/23

A mandatory contestant meeting will be at 7:00 pm Friday. This will provide contestants the opportunity to meet the judges, ask questions and get information and materials for Event 1.

Category 1 - Punch Party Meet and Greet. 10:00pm.

Contestants will create and prepare a party punch that will be served to campers attending the dance party. Contestants will be assigned, at random, one liquor and one mandatory mixer that must be used. Contestants can also use items from a provided pantry of mixers as well to make their punch as well as bring their own mixers to use. Assigned liquor, assigned mixer, cooler, ice and cups will be provided to each contestant. Points will be awarded based on taste and creativity of punch as well as contestants' interaction with campers while serving the punch. All judges will be present.

SATURDAY (DAY) - 09/09/23

Contestants will meet at 10:00 am Saturday to collect materials for 50/50 Challenge and information for the event.

Category 2 - 50/50 Challenge. 10:00 am - 6:00 pm.

Contestants will be issued raffle tickets and a collection bucket at the contestant meeting Saturday Morning. Contestants will have from 10am until 6pm to sell as many tickets as possible using the pricing guide as discussed at the meeting. Points will be awarded in accordance with the scoring system used throughout the contest based on total tickets sold and funds raised. All judges will be monitoring contestant progress throughout the challenge.

Category 3 - Erect It. 2:00pm.

Contestants must erect a small tent provided as quickly as possible. Points awarded for completion and success of tent erection in accordance with the point system used throughout the contest. All judges will be present.

Location: Grass area adjacent to Lanai.

Category 4 - Light my Fire. 2:30pm.

Contestants must build a campfire as quickly as possible and keep it lit for a minimum of 5 minutes. Materials will be provided. You will be judged on completion time to light fire lit as well as how robust the fire is. Points awarded in accordance with the scoring system used throughout the contest. All judges will be present.

SATURDAY (EVENING) - 09/09/23

Pre-show. 6:30pm. Lanai.

Contestants must be backstage and ready for the contest at 6:30 pm. Judges will be in place at 6:45 pm.

Category 5 - Camp Wear or Wear Not. 7:00pm.

Contestants must wear their most functional and fabulous camp attire - function and fashion! Points awarded for creativity and aspects of utilitarianism. The category will be completed on stage the evening of the contest and points will be awarded in accordance with the standard point system used throughout the contest.

Category 6 - How Campy are You? 7:00pm.

Random questions about the campground and its history will be asked to each contestant. Points awarded by number of creative and correct answers and in accordance with the standard point system used throughout the contest. The category will be completed in the evening of the contest.
