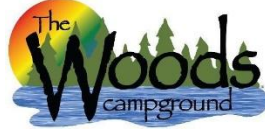


2027 Woods Bear, Cub, & Daddy Contest

CONTESTANT RULES & APPLICATION

Please read in its entirety!



APPLICATIONS:

Completed applications must be received by or before 11:59pm on Saturday, September 4th, 2026. Applications are to be submitted by emailing to MrWoodsBear24@gmail.com (Subject: 2027 Woods Bear Contest) or dropped off at the Camp office.

CONTEST ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

This contest is an event in the LGBT community: Therefore, all contestants must be at least 18 years of age and should self-identify as gay, bisexual, non-binary, and/or transgender. The Woods Bear, Cub, & Daddy Contest is open to all LGBT identifying persons and all members of The Woods Campground community (including all permanent, weekend and day campers). Exceptions: Contestants cannot be sitting members of the Bear Committee and/or the current Woods Bear, Cub, or Daddy Titleholder. The contest is not an official feeder contest to any other competition, but winning Woods titleholders are welcome to compete in additional regional contests at their discretion.

JUDGING METHOD:

Full-point (non-Olympic) scoring will be used in selecting the winners of the contest. The Olympic Scoring System will be used in the event of a tie. If both the non-Olympic and Olympic scores are tied, the judging panel will meet to break the tie. Keep in mind that judges do not necessarily look for the prettiest face, most fit and/or bear body, but rather the person who best typifies the ideal bear. This involves the personal subjective judgment of each contestant's bear image, participation in the bear community, physical appearance, attitude, personality, self-assurance, and "presence."

FRATERNIZATION WITH JUDGES:

Contestants and judges may fraternize informally in public situations. **Private meetings or personal contact between judges and contestants during the contest weekend are absolutely prohibited.** Any behavior that might create even the appearance of bias will be brought to the attention of the Woods Bear, Cub, & Daddy Contest producers and other judges, who will decide if the disqualification of the judge and/or contestant would be prudent. To avoid accidental violation of propriety, all contestants and judges **must** display their respective identification badges whenever they are in public places during the contest weekend.

JUDGING CATEGORIES AND SCORING:

There will be 5 judged categories – 100 points maximum:

Judges Interview: (Maximum 20 points)

There will be a brief 10-to-12-minute, private interview with each contestant during the day prior to the contest, to get to know the contestant better.

Swimwear: (Maximum 20 points)

Contestants will appear on stage in what they feel to be their most appropriate swimsuit. Unlike many other contests, this segment is not an "exotic fashion show" or "body competition", but an exploration of our bear lifestyle, and will be judged as such. Each contestant should try to emphasize, by their choice of swimsuit, what they believe is their "most appropriate" look to the audience and judges.

Bear/Bar Wear: (Maximum 25 points)

Contestants will appear on stage in bar or camp wear of their choice. They will be introduced to the audience. Each contestant will be asked a question submitted by either the judges or The Woods Campground community. Contestants will not have advanced knowledge of the question.

Formal Wear: (Maximum 25 points)

Contestants will appear on stage in formal attire of their choice. They will make a brief statement about why they would like to hold the title of Woods Bear, Cub, & Daddy.

Social Skills: (Maximum 10 points)

Contestants will go around introducing themselves and selling raffle tickets. This will not only show the judges how much each contestant interacts with the public but also allows the public to vote for contestants based on personal interaction.

BONUS – Raffle Ticket Sales: (Maximum 5 points)

The public will also have a say in determining the winning contestants for Woods Bear, Cub, & Daddy by purchasing raffle tickets from them. All monies collected will be split between The Woods Bear Fund, Titleholder travel fund, and the winning Bear sash family charity. Contestants are allowed one person to assist them during the allotted raffle period. The assistant is not allowed to sell raffles. All sales must be conducted by the contestant. If found otherwise, the contestant will forfeit all points for Social Skills.

Points will be awarded to the TOP THREE ticket sale contestants in all categories of the Bear, Cub, & Daddy contest.

- The contestant with the highest sales will receive **5** bonus points added to their final score.
- The contestant with the second highest sales will receive **3** bonus points added to their final score.
- The contestant with the third highest sales will receive **1** bonus point added to their final score.

If there are fewer than 3 contestants entered in any contest, **5** bonus points will still be added to the final score of the receiver of the most ticket sales, and **3** bonus points added to the receiver of the second most ticket sales.

Minimum Scoring for a single contestant:

If there is only one contestant in any of the Woods Bear, Cub, & Daddy contests, the contestant must still participate in all the contest-related events and compete in the contest itself. A minimum score of 75% of the total points allowed by judges within the contest must be achieved for the contestant to be named the "winner".

GATHERINGS:

See the schedule of events listed for all required gatherings during the Woods Bear, Cub, & Daddy Contests weekend. ALL contestants and judges MUST attend each scheduled meeting and/or event as listed. Please be on time! Failure to meet these requirements may result in loss of points or removal from the contest.

WHAT IS EXPECTED OF THE WINNERS?

The primary duty of Woods Bear, Cub, & Daddy titleholders are to represent the Bear and LGBT communities while also representing The Woods Campground, in the best light possible.

At a minimum, the contest winners will:

- Attend a Pride Event in their corresponding communities as a representative of The Woods Campground. Titleholders are required to wear their sash during the event. Titleholders may also attend one or more of the following: Reading, Capital City, New Hope, Lancaster, Wilkes-Barre, Philadelphia, Baltimore, New York City, or Asbury Park Pride events.
- Organize 3 fundraising events* in camp (together or separately from each other, your choice), to benefit:
 1. A local (to The Woods Campground), non-profit community or LGBT organization. The beneficiary organization must be approved in advance by the Woods Bear, Cub, and Daddy Contest Producers. Assistance may be provided by the producers and/or Bear committee members.
- Attend and participate at all three Bear weekends at The Woods Campground during their title year. This Includes assisting with the Thursday Bear dinner during Bear week.

- Help host a "Meet and Greet" cocktail party for the Woods Bear, Cub, and Daddy Titleholders during Bears 4 (OkoBEAR Fest) weekend of The Woods Campground Camping season.
- Organize and host The Woods off-season event in conjunction with the Leather and Drag Titleholders. This event is to bring the community together and raise money for one and/or all Charities that the titleholders choose.

*Failure to complete the above obligations and/or flagrant violation of Woods Campground rules or titleholder expectations may result in forfeiture of the Woods Bear, Cub, & Daddy Title (and sash, etc.) at the discretion of The Woods Bear Contest Producers)

* Any fundraising events must be pre-approved through the Woods Bear, Cub, & Daddy producers. If an event is to be held at the campground, it must then be approved by the campground. Names of said events and fundraisers become property of the Woods Bear, Cub, & Daddy producers and may not be used without written consent. Thorough research of ANY events in the surrounding areas by supporting or any other bear run/event must be performed prior to getting permission. No event will be allowed if there is another event within a 300-mile radius.

Any events past the title year of the winners must have written consent to use the title of "Woods Bear, Cub, & Daddy" in any event.

All monies raised at ANY event/fundraiser must be reported within 1 hour after completion of event/fundraiser to the Woods producers and counting of monies must be witnessed by either a producer of the Woods Bear, Cub, & Daddy contest or a third party NOT affiliated with the Woods titleholder personally. Said monies then must be sent to The Woods Campground 3500 Forest St. Lehigh, PA 18235 ATTN: Dan within 48 hours which will be held until step down. Titleholders are also responsible for keeping accurate records of monies raised.

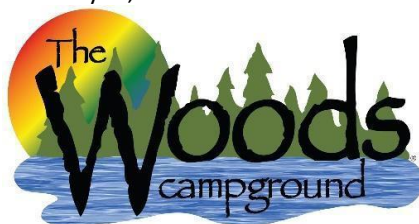
Titleholders are EXPECTED to be at all three bear weekends and to help host activities on all Bear weekends.

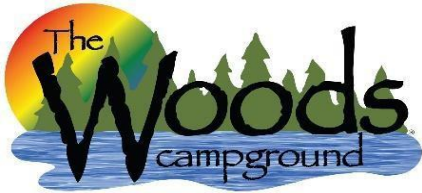
